Annual Meeting of Friends of Palestine Orchestra

Mrs. Ethel Hayman was unanimously re-elected chairman of the S.A. Friends of the Palestine Orchestra, Habimah and Ohel, at the annual general meeting held last Sunday night at the home of Mrs. F. Behrmann.

The hon. president of the society is Mrs. S. G. Millin, with Dr. M. C. Weiler and Mr. H. L. Karnovsky as vice-presidents. A committee of 20 was chosen to carry on the ambitious programme of the society, with Mr. Solly Yellin as vice-chairman.

Rabbi Dr. M. C. Weiler, in addressing the gathering, stressed the value of institutions like the Palestine Orchestra and Habimah in their relation to world Jewry. Jews in all parts of the world could draw influences from the artistic movements in the Yishuv, while those institutions themselves were prevented from becoming provincial by the reciprocal influences drawn from world Jewry. It was the relationship of centre and circumference — mutually beneficial and necessary.

A watch was presented by the society to Mrs. Dorah Sowden, who is shortly leaving for overseas and who has worked on the committee for several years. Mrs. Hayman, in making the presentation, expressed the society's appreciation of Mrs. Sowden's help.
