## PASSOVER RECIPES

### APPLE FRITTERS

**HERE** is an old-time favourite, made with Matzo meal, that is ready in a jiffy and takes little time from your preparation of the main course. The recipe is:

- 3 tart apples.
- 1 cup Matzo meal.
- 3 Eggs.
- 2 tablespoonfuls melted vegetable shortening.
- ½ teaspoon salt.
- ½ cup water.

Peel apples and slice thin; mix other ingredients into a smooth batter; dip apple slices into batter and deep-fry until the fritters are golden brown. Strain on brown paper, sprinkle with cinnamon and sugar and serve.
