**Brilliant Young Pianist  
To Tour Union**  
*Sigi Weissenberg Arriving Soon*



JUST over two years ago there arrived in Palestine a group of refugees from Bulgaria. With them came a lad of thirteen, Sigi Weissenberg, and his mother.

In the temporary quarters they occupied in Jerusalem the lad was heard to improvise on the piano. Listeners who became intrigued at the music the boy was playing learned to their amazement and delight that they were his own com-

positions. A private recital was arranged at the house of a well-known lover of music. It did not take those present long to realise that in Sigi Weissenberg from Sofia they had discovered a rare musical "find."

Interested friends began arranging the boy's immediate mode of life. A piano was placed at his disposal. Together with his mother he went to live in an artistically arranged home. A period of rest and study was mapped out for him and the young genius was given lessons in Hebrew.

Sigi Weissenberg at 15 is a mature virtuoso and composer, and has been widely acclaimed by Palestinian audiences.

By arrangement with African Consolidated Theatres he will give a concert tour in the Union in June. He is expected to arrive in Johannesburg with his mother about the middle of May.

**U.Z.P. Affiliates With General Zionists**

its role in the organisation of General Zionism throughout the world.

After discussion, it was unanimously decided to confirm the affiliation of the United Zionist Party to the Confederation of General Zionists.

**Importance of Affiliation**

Mr. Bernard Gering, in a short address, dealt with a number of issues that arose in the course of the discussion. He stressed the importance of linking up with the Confederation of General Zionists through whom it would be possible for the United Zionist Party to participate in the activities of the World Zionist Movement.

As far as the delegation to Congress was concerned, they should represent the aims, views and decisions of the United Zionist Party and be directed to work as a team and to abide by the majority decisions of the delegation as a whole.

It was also decided that in the formulation of any political demands

the goal of a Jewish State shall be a sine qua non.

A number of other resolutions were adopted as a guide to the delegation that would be proceeding overseas.

**Nomination of Delegates**

Eighteen members of the Party throughout the country were then nominated as candidates for the election to Congress. In view of the fact that the exact number of South African delegates to Congress was not yet known, it was decided to leave the final selection of candidates to the South African United Zionist Party Council. As soon as a decision is taken these names will be published in the press.

Mr. B. Gering expressed his pleasure at the success of the Conference deliberations and urged delegates to organise and mobilise all forces for the coming election.

Mr. I. Dunsky thanked the delegates for their co-operation, and appealed for a maximum effort in the coming elections.

**OBITUARY**

**Mr. Samuel Borok (Muizenberg)**

The death of Mr. Samuel Borok, which took place at Muizenberg in the prime of his life, cast a gloom over the whole community. Simple and unassuming by nature, he was held in highest esteem and was beloved by all who knew him.

The late Mr. Borok lived in Durbanville for many years and was the backbone of the community there. Some years ago he moved to Muizenberg and immediately made a mark on the community through his congregational and Zionist activities. He was a man of deep religious feeling and was a lover of Jewish learning and tradition. He took an interest in all charitable institutions in Cape Town and was a supporter of every Jewish cause.

Mr. Borok was a devoted Zionist and rendered invaluable service to the cause. For the last 25 years he was an active member of the Dorshei Zion Association. When the W.P. Zionist Council was formed he was one of the first to be elected as a representative for the suburbs. He only retired recently on account of ill-health.

He leaves a widow, three sons and two daughters.

**Mr. Moritz Liebman**

THE death occurred in Pretoria on Sunday last, of Mr. Moritz Liebman, a pioneer of that city, and the last remaining member of the Jewish community who was associated with President Kruger.

Mr. Liebman arrived in Pretoria in 1889, and ever since then has been closely identified with the life of the Jewish community. He was one of the founders of the Pretoria Hebrew Congregation and the Pretoria Jewish Helping Hand and Burial Society and was Hon. Life President of both these institutions. He was also a founder of the Miriam Marks Hebrew School and of the Jewish Memorial Hall, in Beatrix Street, of which he laid the foundation stone. Shortly before the outbreak of war he endowed the Moritz Liebman Ward at the Pretoria General Hospital.

He is survived by three daughters and two sons, Mrs. H. Polliack and Dr. Julius Liebman, of Johannesburg, Mrs. C. Podlashuc, Mrs. J. Weinstein and Mr. Solly Liebman, of Pretoria.

A large and representative gathering attended the funeral, at which Rabbi W. Hirsch and the Rev. Zwick officiated.

**Mr. Mark Simenhoff (Cape Town)**

Mr. Mark Simenhoff passed away recently in Cape Town in his 93rd year. He was born in Rossiani in 1853 and came to South Africa in 1881.

He founded the Synagogue at Robertson and later came to live in the Cape. He was the first Jew to settle at Maitland and founded the Synagogue there and became its first president.

He often officiated at yomtovim in an honorary capacity at the Old Synagogue in the Avenue, the Cape Jewish Orphanage, at Sea Point and at other places. He was deeply religious, had a keen sense of humour and made friends wherever he went—a friend to all.

He is survived by his widow, two sons and four daughters.

**Mrs. Bertha Sagorsky (Cape Town)**

The death took place on April 17 of Mrs. Bertha Sagorsky, a well-known member of the community.

The late Mrs. Sagorsky was a woman of fine personality and will be sadly missed by a wide circle of friends. She was closely attached to Eretz Israel, which she visited some years ago, and it was her dearest wish to return and make her home there.

Her sons and daughter are prominent members of the community and keen supporters of the Zionist cause.
