OBITUARY

Dr. Joshua Mazell

THE sad and premature death of
Dr. Joshua Mazell, which oc-
curred in Boksburg last Saturday
afternoon, is a grievous loss to that
community and particularly to the
Hebrew Order of David, to which he
had rendered yeoman service.

Dr. Mazell, who was 43 years of
age, graduated at the Witwatersrand
University and then qualified over-
seas as an ear, nose and throat
specialist. On his return to the
Union he practised in Boksburg and
was on the honorary staff of the
Germiston and Boksburg hospitals.
During the war he took an active
interest in the C.P.S. and the Red
Cross.

He had been closely associated
with the Hebrew Order of David for
a period of about nine years. He
was a Past President of the Sir
Rufus Isaacs Lodge, Boksburg, a
member of the Grand Executive and
of the H.O.D. Senate as well as a
trustee of the Order's Educational
Fund. He worked with unflagging
zeal for the ideals of the Order.

The funeral on Sunday afternoon
was attended by H.O.D. members
from all parts of the Reef, as well
as the Mayor and Councillors of
Boksburg. A memorial service was
held in the Talmud Torah Hall where
fitting tributes were paid by mem-
bers of the Order to the inspiring
lead which Dr. Mazell had given to
the Order and to the community in
general.

The deceased was unmarried, and
is survived by his mother, Mrs. Anita
Mazell, sister, brother-in-law and
nephew.
