If Israel Is Destroyed Western Civilisation Will Not Survive

Lecture by Ben Weinbren to H.O.D.

A most interesting lecture was recently given by Councillor Ben Weinbren on the "Future of Palestine" to the Hebrew Order of David. Mr. Percy Rappoport presided.

It was essential to recognise, said Councillor Weinbren, that if the State of Israel is destroyed, Western civilisation would not survive. In this atomic age, he said, Western civilisation cannot survive unless collective security was guaranteed to all nations. The League of Nations failed because the major powers were blind and disinterested in the security of small nations, and he said, it was due to this that Japan invaded Manchuria in 1931 and Hitler violated Versailles and occupied the Rhineland in 1938.

In 1933 when Hitler saw this success on a small scale, he proceeded with wholesale slaughter afterwards. The fault, in Councillor Weinbren's opinion, could be placed at the door of the League of Nations who were blind and disinterested in the struggle of smaller nations.

A similar thing was occurring today in the case of Palestine. Despite the United Nations with all its powers and decisions, the Arabs flouted everything and invaded Palestine.

Dark and dangerous days face us, Councillor Weinbren continued, and the Palestine issue bristles with danger; but we Jews' are a remarkable race. There has been a one-sided war against us all the time, a war from Nebuchadnezzar to Bevin. But the Jews have never lost their spirit. Whether it was in the concentration camps of Terblinka, Maidanek or Bergen Belsen where the

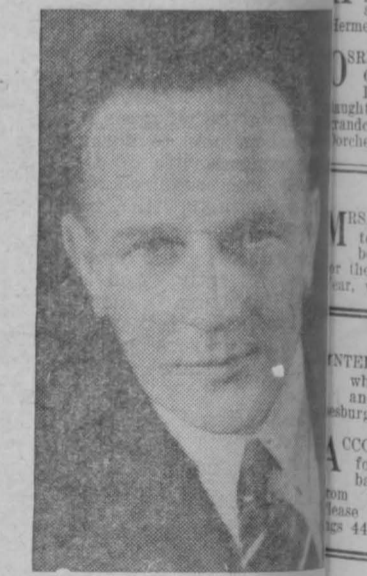
