FREE HOSPITALISATION

THE doctors' point of view on the controversy of free hospitalisation in the Transvaal was explained by Dr. Maurice Shapiro in an address at the Zionist Luncheon Club.

Dr. Shapiro, who is a fluent and most interesting speaker, gave a dedetailed exposition of the issue as it developed during the last few years and argued that the present scheme would not be for the benefit of the poor and that the poor section would be victimised if the free hospitalisation scheme were introduced.

He quoted extensively from official documents and authorities on hospitalisation in support of his case.

Dr. Norman Klass was in the chair.

The point of view of the Transvaal Provincial Administration was given by Dr. E. B. Woolf, M.E.C., at last Friday's meeting of the Luncheon Club.

The Hospital Ordinance, he said, was one of the greatest social measures that had ever been introduced in this country. Up till now, if a patient could afford to pay for his bed in hospital, he was compelled to pay for everything else, with the result that he often found himself with an intolerable financial burden. Under the new ordinance, the patient could still choose to pay his own doctor and yet have completely free hospitalisation.

The majority voted that £500 should be devoted to the I.U.A. and £250 to the M.D.A. in memory of J. Goldberg and S. Kahn, two 19-year-old Jewish lads from Kurshan, who

fell in the heroic defence of Israel (J. Goldberg was an inmate of the notorious Dachau concentration camp). It was also voted that a further £500 should be spent on sending parcels to landsleit in Lithuania. The remaining £250 should be kept by the society in reserve for unforeseen emergencies.

The following is a brief account of the achievements of the society:

The sum of over £5,000 was donated by about 40 of our members, who have done and given of their best to aid the survivors of Kurshan, and have also taken an active part in the work of the J.W.A.

The society was most active during the war years in helping over 200 Jews from Kurshan, who fled from the German armies and found refuge in Soviet Russia. This help continued after the liberation of Lithuania by the Red Army, when the Kurshaner refugees returned to Lithuania. In those years, when a parcel meant the salvation of many, the society sent several hundreds of these parcels to the survivors.
