Mark 9:23 - 'If it is possible!' said Jesus.  
'Everything is possible to one who has faith!'  
- Hypnotic to believe this statement about  
belief.

① Transformation (3 Evangelists): Let  
- stay! Christ: my work not yet finished.  
my task not fulfilled - lies at the foot  
- amongst men.

② Scene at foot: Quarrel between the  
theologians of the Phar & the disc -

The church on the defensive - trying to  
justify itself. When Christ asks what  
is this about both parties are silent -  
father speaks up: the man in need.

③ The man in need & the church: Come  
to the disciples as repres of the church.  
We are the repes of Christ & -

- our enormous responsibility
- our glorious opportunity

Q: What may the world justifiably expect  
Does it not have the right to expect love,  
understanding, sympathy, help, release?

a) Disc seemingly fails to heal child in  
own strength

b) Christ wanted them to realize that their  
strength does not lie there

→ We cannot even carry the burden over our  
need & problems (Mindless) → How  
much less that of others? Without prayer  
& fasting - no help! The most you can  
do is to get cross with such a person

④ Soul spirit: Signs of ailments -  
sickness described to soul spirits -  
Epilepsy - We regard it as a pri-  
itive concept which we reject (African).  
But what must the disc have done?

a) They should not have believed  
in their own power but in that of  
the hand

b) They should definitely have prayed  
for the healing of the son of this  
man

c) They should have understood that  
~~our~~ life illness is a revelation of the  
brokenness of our existence and the  
world of men - that our life is beset  
with evil powers which will only be  
conquered finally with the ex-  
istence of God.
