- Commemorative sense - not to honour Rev. Sudd.
as but to thank God for the contribution that
made not only to the conquest of Dhule,
the UNESA (Junbes DCA) but above all,
to the Kingdom of God.

- 1) His concern for the poor, the marginalized,
the unemployed (care source of mercy which he
organized in Dhule)
- 2) His concern for his fellow ministers of
the Church - their spiritual growth
- their material needs (pension
fund)
- 3) His emphasis on integrity - transparency -
honesty

How can we now as a congregation,
as a church WRCSA (esp. our own regional
Synod of S.F. S. Tr.) do justice to his
memory?

- 1) By proving our concern for the poor,
not only through our diens v. Seruhatyha,
but also to ask: what more can we
do to bridge the gap between rich v.
poor in our country?
 - 2) By proving that we will as a church to
do more to ensure that our ministers
(when they retire) have a reasonable pension
to live by!
 - 3) By assisting all those who wish to
build a culture of honesty, of trans-
parency, of integrity in our church!
