



HUNDREDS of people of all races attended the funeral yesterday in Lusaka, reports Sapa, of Mr. Todd Matshikiza, South African-born composer of the all-African jazz opera, "King Kong." Mr. Matshikiza died here in hospital on Sunday.

Among those who attended the funeral service were Government Ministers, Mrs. Betty Kaunda, wife of President Kaunda, the American Ambassador to Zambia, Mr. Robert Good, and many Black South African exiles.

Cars stretching for more than a mile accompanied the cortege to his final resting place at Leopard's Hill.

Mr. Matshikiza who leaves a widow and two children, left South Africa in 1960 for Britain after having worked as chief reporter for Drum Magazine in Johannesburg. He is to have a monument erected in his honour for the cultural work he did for Zambia.
