LONDON — Stanley Kubrick's latest film, "The Shining," will not be unduly delayed by a fire which severely damaged a set at EMI's Elstree studio.

Most of the work on the film has been completed.

The fire, believed to have been caused by an electrical fault, began on a stage which was not being used.

To rebuild scenery will take only a few days, says a Kubrick spokesman. — The Star Bureau.
