The Sirkin Choir from Israel is coming to the Cape on April 1st, 1998 for five festive concerts. It will also participate in the Klein Karoo Festival at Oudtshoom, and give three concerts: on April 4th,5th and 6th. A festive Jubilee Anniversary Concert celebrating 50 years of Independence of the State of Israel will be on April 8th in Cape Town. An additional concert appearance will be on April 12th at The Stellenbosch University, with the Bellville Civic Choir.

The Sirkin Choir was founded in 1978 - originally as a singing group of local enthusiasts who performed mainly Israeli Folksongs. Through excellent musical management it has had tremendous success in its performances in Europe, where it has been able to acquaint a variety of crowds with beautiful Israeli music and lyrics.

Among the 40 members of the Choir one can find business people, farmers accountants, nurses and teachers.

Kefar Sirkin, a lovely village near Tel-Aviv, was established in 1936 and named after Nahman Sirkin, the great Zionist leader from Russia.
