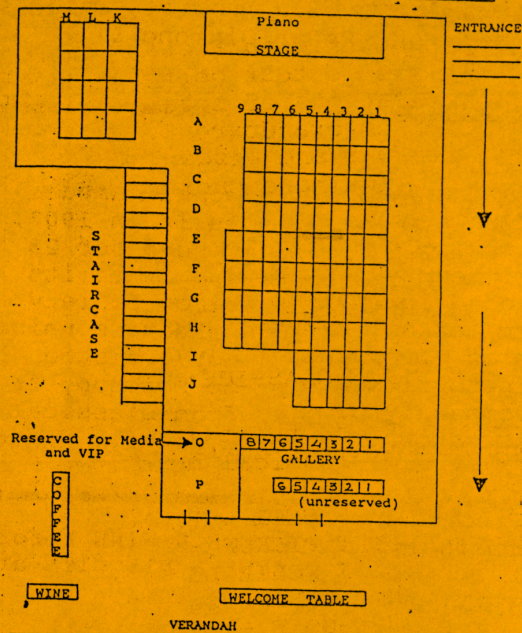

Longnor House:

Longnor House with its oak-beamed hall seating 100, was built in 1903. Des and Dawn have lived here for 26 years, lovingly restoring it to its original beauty. The Soiree Society was founded in 1971 to create a unique platform for all kinds of artistic expression, from jazz to baroque, from township to flamenco, from classical to contemporary cabaret, poetry, dance, mime and satire.

UP Munro Drive:

Turn North into Elm St, right into St. Patrick Road.
