Longnor House was built in 1903. Des and Dawn have lived here for 26 years, lovingly restoring it to its original beauty.

The chapel-like oak-beamed hall seats 100, making this the ideal intimate venue for solo recitals, chamber music, jazz, contemporary song, satire, mime, drama and even dance.

Johnny Clegg and Sipho Mchunu gave their first public Johannesburg performances here, as did John Kani and Winston Ntshona (Fugard's *Sizwe Bansi is Dead*), and The Soweto String Quartet. Des and Dawn have hosted Mercedes Molina and her Spanish Dance Company, Rod McKuen, Oswald Mtshali, The Drakensberg Boys Choir, Hugh Masekela, Jonas Gwangwa, Geina Mhlope, Mara Louw, Judy Page, Gerard Korsten, Jennifer Ferguson, The Bonegio Spanish Dance Company, Nico Carstens, Sipho "Hotstix" Mabuse, Peter Yarrow (Of Peter, Paul and Mary), Johannes Kerkerrel, Ray Phiri, Victor Masondo, and some 1500 more top musicians and performers in the twenty three years since the Soirées were first presented.
