Mr. Eden Requests More Railway Jobs For Our People

It was acknowledged that the Minister of Transport, Mr. B. J. Schoeman, had made a successful attempt to introduce Coloured persons into the Railway Service. His plea was that the Minister should apply his mind to the question of making more jobs available to Coloureds, to the question of giving better pension benefits to employees, and seeing that generally speaking the travelling conditions for Coloureds were improved, Mr. Graham Eden said in Parliament.

Instead of paying "mere pittance" by way of salaries and wages" a very strong group of trained, skilled Coloured personnel could be established, which would do a first class job and be an asset to the Railways.

Referring annual wages of R400 and R450, Mr. Eden said: "It is not a wage on which a person can keep body and soul together in this country."

Mr. Eden asked the Minister whether the system obtaining of paying a small, additional wage for what was known as "better class" work would not be on an avenue where the Coloured employees might be paid a little more so that his position might get some status.

Mr. Eden said Coloured travellers expressed some dissatisfaction because first and second class Coloured passengers were expected to use the same waiting rooms as third-class passengers. The Minister had said that other accommodation was made available where possible. He suggested however, that waiting rooms be provided at the various stations.
