THE ZUID-AFRIKAAN.
CAPE TOWN, DECEMBER 14, 1848.

A rare spectacle was witnessed in this city on Monday last, we mean the procession of a body of about one hundred and fifty Agriculturists from the Matieland Division to Government House...

The farmers have but little leisure, particularly as it is now harvest time, the majority of them are moreover without hands, and many have been compelled to abandon a very considerable portion of their crops, which are now perishing on the field...

It is but proper here to remark, that the very appropriate course adopted by the agriculturists in this instance, was their own voluntary act, and that no person here knew anything of their intention, before they entered the city on Monday last...

About a hundred and fifty inhabitants of Riebeeck Kasteel and Matieland, with their dependants at their head, proceeded on Monday last to Government House, where, after a proper request, His Excellency had declared, he would receive them at 10 o'clock...

The Field-marshal requested that Mr. A. FAURE, as their interpreter, to read to His Excellency the points, which they wished to submit to His Excellency...

Mr. FAURE then read as follows:—That they decidedly object under existing circumstances, to the compulsory military service of any sort, especially in the frontier of the colony...

Mr. BASSON.—The law does not state, that you will not do it; but you may call us out whenever and wherever you like...

Mr. LAUBACHER.—But we are not to be made soldiers, what need have we of a Court Martial? The Governor.—But that Court Martial is composed of your own officers; no community can exist without a proper discipline...

Mr. BASSON.—But I cannot divert myself of the law, that I am not a burgher, when there is a Court Martial, and where there is a Court Martial there must be a soldier...

to reap my corn with my boy of 8 years old, because I could not hire another person, and how shall I obtain a substitute? The Governor.—I see that you would be convinced, that this law was made for your best...

Mr. BASSON.—We shall all be prepared to a man, not one to be behind. The Governor.—As I told you before, I shall only want 100 of you, who should know what they have to do...

Mr. LAUBACHER.—But we have received nothing, how have we to understand it? The Governor.—All the people cannot be paid at once, one after the other, each his turn...

Mr. FAURE read, as requested, further:—That they have seen with regret that the tolls have been increased. That the roads already pressed most severely and unequally upon the poor...

The Governor.—All cannot be accomplished at once. One part of the community has often to suffer inconvenience for a short period, in order more fully afterwards to participate with the whole community in the advantages...

Mr. LAUBACHER.—I now pay 6 pence for my wagon with 8 horses in a load of corn, next year I shall be obliged to pay 9 pence for my wagon and 8 pence for my horses...
