THE GERMAN LEGION.—In the House of Commons, on the 29th May, Mr. Adderley called attention to the expenditure in 12 months for locating the German Legion at the Cape, which he described as a most costly experiment.

BRITISH KAFFRARIA.—At the suggestion of the Lord Bishop of Grahamstown, while on his visit at King William's Town, a Committee has been formed there for the purpose of a "ministry of relief" to the wretched objects who are now daily thronging into that town for work and food.

LATEST ENGLISH NEWS.—The R. M. S. Tynemouth, from Dartmouth the 6th June, arrived in Table Bay on Monday last.

CAPE WINES.—The advices relative to the price of wine, continue favourable. Pontac was sold at from £31 to £32 per pipe, and white wine at from £20 to £22.

"Should the vintage fail in Europe, of which there seems every probability, as the disease has already broken out at Oporto and other districts, we shall want as much Cape wine as we can send us, to supply the deficiency; but we do not think that you can calculate on such high rates (£31 to £32 for pontac and £21 to £22 for white wine)."

The following letter has been received from Mr. Merrington, addressed to the editor of the Mercantile Advertiser, on the important subject of the wine produce of the Cape:—"Sir, Three or four months ago I left on the translation of a French pamphlet on the subject of wine making, by the application of sugar and water to the husks of the grapes, after the juice has been expressed in the ordinary way."

For home consumption it answers very well, but not otherwise, so far as known at present. I am sorry to have to remark that some recent importations of Cape wine have been of inferior quality; and would again impress upon the growers the extreme importance of care at the present period.

PS. The importations of wine from the Cape in four months, ending 30th April:—1855, 50,806 gallons; 1856, 113,839 do.; 1857, 193,975 do. Duty paid in same period, 1855, 69,805 gallons; 1856, 103,288 do.; 1857, 170,385 do.

Mr. Labouchere defended the measure, the benefit of which both to another country and to England he saw very clearly; and whilst admitting that the colonists should make efforts to protect themselves, he denounced it as the height of absurdity to expect this, when they knew that the colony was in a position to defend themselves.

Mr. P. O'Brien said that the German Legion had been enlisted under a promise that they would receive pay and make colonists at the Cape or Canada. If this was considered such an immense advantage, he wondered why only 2000 had accepted the boon offered to the 10,000?

At a subsequent sitting, on the 25th May, when the Estimates came under consideration, Mr. Adderley again reverted to the subject, and sought in detail to show that the expense attending the location of the Legion at the Cape had been said that the Cape Parliament had voted £40,000; this was for the whole 10,000; but only 2,300 having been sent, this vote would be reduced to about one-third.

Mr. Labouchere defended the course adopted by the Government in sending the Legion to the Cape, and maintained that they were the best adapted to serve as military settlers, having been trained under their own officers to act, if need be, in a body.

Mr. Adderley was determined to go to the vote upon his amendment, not to undo the thing which had been done, but to stop experiments and save the country from any repetition thereof; but after hearing the opinion of some other members and finding the sense of the House against him, he, by leave of the House, withdrew the amendment.

The vessel which will be commanded by Capt. McClintock is a three-masted yacht fitted with an auxiliary screw and engines of 30 horse-power.

Under the existing state of the law the Attorney General has decided upon prosecuting the directors of the notorious Royal British Bank.

These matters may perhaps appear dull to your readers in general, but they are here considered of great importance and have caused much satisfaction in commercial and trading classes.

The official announcement of the betrothal of the Princess Royal to the eldest son of the Prince of Prussia and after his father her presumptive to the throne of that Kingdom, has been made and in reply to her Majesty's message both Houses of Parliament voted most loyal addresses of congratulation.
