To us, South African Colonists, one of the most interesting items of news is, that our metropolitan has at last succeeded in getting a "head to fit" the Maritzburg mitre, that has been so long in the market. It used to be the highest ambition of a clerical functionary to attain the dignity of Bishop, but it appears now, that Colonial Sees are occasionally found going a begging. We are not aware of the persuasive eloquence, and profound arguments that Bishop Gray may have brought to bear on his novice, but we have strong reasons to believe, that the persuasive powers of the former, prevailed over the caution and astuteness of the latter. It is not every man, or every hundred of men even to enter the lists of polemical theology, or criticism or learning, or even law, with one of the most distinguished, and brightest geniuses of the age; and the Rev. Mr. Macrorie, A.M., must either be a man of a very gigantic, or of a comparatively pigmy intellectual calibre, to take up the cudgels against Colenso. Perhaps however he is but partially acquainted with the difficulties connected with the post which he has been called upon to fill, and therefore his acceptance of the office may have been based on imperfect or incorrect information, and that he is accordingly to be exempted from any particular desire on his part to have a tilt against the redoubtable Bishop of Natal. Should this prove to be the case, Mr. Macrorie is more to be pitied than condemned.
