Eighth Annual Statement of the Transactions of the Malmesbury Agricultural and Commercial Bank, laid before a General Meeting of Shareholders on the 15th July, 1870.

IN submitting the Eighth Annual Statement the Directors of the Malmesbury Agricultural and Commercial Bank beg to inform the Shareholders that the transactions of the Bank during the past year have, on the whole, been favourable. The Gross Receipts amount to £3,519 17s 11d, being £304 7s 5d in excess of that of the previous year; the Profit and Loss Account, however, will show that of this amount the large sum of £1,959 1s 6d, has been absorbed in the payment of Interest on Fixed Deposits. Since the commencement of the present year, Directors have lowered the rate of Interest to 4 per cent; the effect of this step will be favourably felt in the Balance Sheet of the ensuing year. The losses during the past financial year amount to about £28. After placing the annual addition of £120 to the Reserve Fund, and providing for all charges connected with the management of the Bank, there will remain an available Balance of £829 4s 6d. Directors recommend that a Dividend of 6 per cent, be declared on the paid-up Capital, that £75 be allowed to Directors for their services, and the balance of £23 4s 8d, be placed to Profit and Loss Account. As the retiring Directors, Messrs. GREYFF and ALBERTYN, have been duly nominated for re-election, the Ballot will be purely formal. The Dividend will be payable on the 5th August next. F. Minutes of Proceedings of Annual Meeting held on the 15th July, 1870.

MICHL, BERG, Esq., in the Chair. The Annual Report having been read, Mr. J. N. HAMMAN, Jun., moves an amendment, seconded by Mr. J. C. WALDROP, "That instead of 6 per cent, the Dividend be declared at Six Shillings per Share, and that the Balance be placed to the Reserve Fund." After discussion the Amendment was carried.—Mr. J. ALBERTYN dissenting. Proposed by Mr. WALDROP, and seconded by Mr. VAN EYSSSEN, "That the Report as amended be adopted."—Carried. The retiring Directors, Messrs. GREYFF and ALBERTYN, being duly elected, a vote of thanks to the Directors and Officers of the Bank and to the Chairman of the Meeting closed the proceedings.
