The first is, "Robert Owen" by G. D. H. Cole, in which we are given the salient facts of Owen's life and influence, and connected with them are the various social and economic movements which his doctrines vitally effected. Here we have a play-wright turned biographer and indeed the author gives us a daring book, for he has brought to bear his dramatic sense and those who are interested in the life of the great Irish leader will find this work indispensable for the study of the subject. Murray and Palmerston" by Philip Guedalla.

Nigerian Days.

It is good for people nowadays to read a book such as "Nigerian Days" by A. C. G. Hastings with an introduction by R. B. Cunninghame Graham and published by John Lane, The Bodley Head, Limited. At once it brings one face to face with the realities of life and lifts the veil that even still conceals how, and in what manner, our present African Empire was built up. Written with great sincerity and with equal modesty it is the record of eighteen long years spent on the confines of the Empire, a book written without spread-eagleism, devoid of bombast, and without the cheap-expression of opinion of the average globe-trotter who in a month is competent to settle the "native" question of a country that he has only seen as in a cinema.

Arnold Schonberg.

Messrs. J. M. Dent & Sons,

Ltd., publish Egon Wellesz's "Arnold Schonberg." This is a brilliant study by an expert musician of Schonberg's creative activity, tracing his development and showing how his dominant personality has gradually expressed itself, transcending the traditions of the past and opening the way to a new and wonderful world of music, the extent of which is as yet only recognised by a few. The translation from the German has been done by W. H. Kerridge.

Sporting and Dramatic Yarns.

A very fine series of sporting and dramatic yarns is R. J. B. Sellar's work of the same title, published by Messrs. T. Fisher Unwin, Limited, at three and sixpence. Mr. R. J. B. Sellar has collected for publication in book form some of the stories which have been amusing readers of the "Illustrated Sporting and Dramatic News" during the last few months. There are stories to note—and quote as one's own—in the drawing-room, in the club smoking-room, and in places where charming people assemble to hear bores make after-dinner speeches; stories of the links, of the race-course, of the cricket-field, and of the hunting-field, of amateur and professional actors, and, of course, of motorists and their cars. The reader will be amused from cover to cover—for the cover has been specially designed by H. M. Bateman and, in a collection of all sorts, he will not find many chestnuts.
