The New High Commissioner for Palestine.

General Wauchope, Commander-in-Chief in Northern Ireland, Appointed.

London, July 13th.

Sir John Chancellor, the High Commissioner for Palestine and Transjordan, has resigned his position as from November 1st next, on the termination of the period for which he accepted the appointment, and His Majesty has been pleased to accept his resignation, says an official statement issued this evening by the Colonial Office.

His Majesty, it is further announced, has been pleased to approve the appointment of Lieut.-General Arthur Grenfell Wauchope, General Officer Commanding the Northern Ireland District, to succeed Sir John Chancellor as High Commissioner and Commander-in-Chief for Palestine and High Commissioner for Transjordan.

Lieut.-General Wauchope, who is 57 years of age, has been General Officer Commanding the Northern Ireland District, stationed in Belfast, since 1929. He entered the Army when he was 19 and served in the Boer War on the staff of the late Major-General Wauchope, commanding the Highland Brigade in South Africa, being severely wounded at Magersfontein. He was in 1902-03 Aide-de-Camp to the Commander-in-Chief of the Cape of Good Hope. When the Great War broke out in 1914 he was a major, being promoted afterwards to colonel. He was wounded and mentioned in despatches. In 1923 he was promoted Major-General, and in 1923 he was Military Member of the Overseas Settlement Delegation to Australia and New Zealand. In 1924-27 he was Chief to the British Section of the Military Inter-Allied Commission of Control in Berlin.

Mr. Felix M. Warburg Officially Resigns.

Chairmanship of Jewish Agency Administrative Committee.

Basle, July 12th.

Mr. Felix M. Warburg submitted to-day his official resignation from the chairmanship of the Administrative Committee of the Jewish Agency, in a letter addressed to the Administrative Committee of the Jewish Agency which opened its session here this afternoon, with Dr. Cyrus Adler in the chair. Thirty-five members of the Administrative Committee and of the Jewish Agency Executive were present at the meeting.

Owing to the state of his health, Mr. Warburg writes, he is compelled to request that his candidature for the office which he has held should not be considered. A detailed statement from Mr. Warburg on the internal situation of the Jewish Agency was also read out to the meeting.

Dr. Weizmann delivered a brief report to the meeting on the political situation, and Dr. Werner Senator, the Treasurer of the Palestine Executive of the Jewish Agency, reported on the financial situation.

Mr. Joseph C. Hyman then presented a report on the activities of the American members of the Administrative Committee.

The Administrative Committee of the Jewish Agency has elected a Budget Committee, a Finance Committee and a Political Committee, which are all starting work to-morrow.
