"The Protocols of Zion"

Apology for Publication by Capetown Journal

IN an editorial in last week's issue of this journal, attention was called to the fact that *The Cape*—a weekly journal published in Capetown — had published in its issue of October 27th, an article entitled 'A Devastating Conspiracy.

In this the writer quoted extensively from the "Protocols of the Learned Elders of Zion." Our editorial pointed out that this ludicrous document, which the anti-Semites dragged out of deserved obscurity for their own purposes twenty or thirty years ago, had been exposed over and over again for the fake and forgery that it is.

As far back as August, 1921, The Times of London published an authoritative exposure of this so-called Jewish peril and referred to the "protocols" as a definite forgery. The late Israel Zangwill published a letter in *The Times* at the same period, showing up the poisonous content of such literary garbage.

The journal in Caretown has now evidently realised the serious error it has committed. In its issue of November 3rd, *The Cape* published the following under the heading of "An Explanation":—

The Cape regrets that in an article titled "A Devastating Conspiracy" which it published recently, the contributor quoted extensively from "The Protocols of the Learned Elders of Zion." Although no anti-Semitic significance was intended to be attached to these quotations as they were used in this instance, such a significance has, in fact been attributed to them.

We wish to state in the most unqualified manner possible *The Cape* dissociates itself absolutely from any policy of anti-Semitism. Several letters have been received from readers of all creeds protesting against the revived use of these "Protocols."

Undisputable proofs exist that the whole "Protocol" fabric is a baseless forgery, and we regret that, inadvertently, extracts from these worthless and malicious documents have been published in an issue of *The Cape*.

Repudiation by Social Credit Movement in S.A.
