INTENSE ACTIVITY AMONG THE YOUTH OF THE TRANSVAAL

ONE of the most important undertakings of the Zionist Youth Movement of South Africa is the publication of a special monthly Youth journal, the "Menorah." This is both the official organ and the mouthpiece of South African young Jewry which truly reflects the life and activity of the Youth. In order to widen the scope of its influence and to obtain that support which it badly needs, a special canvass of Johannesburg has been arranged by the Transvaal Menorah administration.

About two hundred canvassers, who will meet at 9.30 in the morning at the South African Zionist Federation (Youth Office), will be taken in cars to various parts of Johannesburg where they will approach every person who has ever supported Zionist efforts in Palestine with a view to making him a subscriber to the "Menorah."

Canvassers are reminded that they will obtain full particulars and details of the Drive on Sunday morning, May 6, at the Youth Office. In the evening special arrangements are being made to entertain all the canvassers.

It is to be hoped that the Jewish public will support this Menorah drive and thereby encourage the Youth in their work which is gradually drawing them into the life of the South African Jewish community to which they will one day be able to render very good service.
