PORTRAIT OF GENERAL SMUTS

MR. NAHUM GUTMAN, the talented Palestinian painter, who is at present on a visit to this country, brought with him an important communication to General Smuts from Mr. Mayer Dizengoff (Mayor of Tel-Aviv).

In this letter, the Mayor of the all-Jewish city of Palestine expresses to General Smuts the great appreciation of the Yishub at the services rendered to Jewish Palestine by the South African statesman. The communication further points out that it was the wish of the municipality of Tel-Aviv to have hung in its art-museum a portrait of the General.

On Thursday last, General Smuts received Mr. Gutman at his home in Irene. The artist was privileged to spend a few hours there and had the pleasure of meeting Mrs. Smuts and other members of the family. At the end of the visit, General Smuts intimated to Mr. Gutman that he cordially accepted the invitation of the Mayor of Tel-Aviv and would sit for the portrait. Sittings will begin next month in Capetown.

Alleged Nazi Propaganda at Cape

On Wednesday last the "Cape Times" published the following in its local news columns:-

Complaints have reached the "Cape Times" that Nazi propaganda is being distributed by members of the crew of the German auxiliary barque Magdalene Vinnen which arrived in port last Thursday.

Four publications handed to the "Cape Times" and alleged to have been distributed aboard the barque consist of:

A 32-page booklet, "The New Germany and Jewry," printed and published in Berlin, which is an elaborate apologia for Hitler's anti-Semitic campaign. The introduction states that "the Government of the new Germany have found themselves compelled to adopt certain legal measures with the help of which a certain limitation is to be imposed upon the position of authority exercised by Jews in all spheres of public life."

The other three booklets are "German workers! To work!"—a report of Hitler's speech at the "opening of the work offensive on March 21, 1934," "One year of National Socialism in Germany," Hitler's speech to the Reichstag in January of this year, and "Germany under Hitler," a collection of views on Germany by various foreign observers.
