HADASSAH PLANTING THREE FORESTS IN PALESTINE

Jerusalem, March 19th.

A SUM of £2,000,000 has been handed over to the Jewish National Fund by Hadassah, the American Women's Zionist Organisation, for the purpose of planting a forest in the name of Justice Louis Brandeis. In addition a special Hadassah forest of 20,000 trees is to be planted near Kiriat Anavim; and a third forest in honour of Miss Henrietta Szold will be planted near the site of the new Medical Centre on Mount Scopus.

A special fund of £65,000 has been collected by the Hadassah for their recent undertaking to retrieve 32,000 dunams of land near the Haifa Bay.

AMERICAN FRIENDS OF HEBREW UNIVERSITY MEET RECTOR

New York, March 24th.

After the concert a gathering was held at which Mr. Foot and Mr. Ben Ami spoke, congratulating the orchestra on its achievements.
