Jewish Folk Songs Recorded.

BEAUTIFUL SINGING BY REV. BACKON.

The large number of people in South Africa who have heard Rev. S. Backon, the principal Cantor at the Benoni Synagogue, sing, will be more than pleased to learn that his voice has been recorded in the singing of four Jewish songs for His Master's Voice gramophone records.

Rev. Backon has a tenor voice of exceptional sweetness and clarity, and it is heard to advantage in his records. He sings four simple folk songs: Gott in Hemmil is a Foter, Der Barditschewar Kaddish, Mai-ko-Mashma-lon, Az Ich volt gevehn Der Boiren Ho-oylom, the singing of which is remarkable not only for their beauty of tone and the clearness of diction, but for the subtlety with which Rev. Backon has managed to invest them with true lewish feeling and understanding. A song is not necessarily Jewish simply because the words are Yiddish. It is Jewish when it succeeds in expressing Jewish soul and thought and personality, and in his renderings of these four songs Rev. Backon has indeed given them the stamp of Jewishness. He understands perfectly the Jew with his strivings and yearnings, the tragedy and the poetry of his life, his simplicity yet lofty idealism, and he has conveyed this understanding to his work. There is nothing forced or exaggerated about his interpretations of these songs, the choice of which, incidentally, reveal excellent taste.

Rev Backon is accompanied at the piano by Mr. Hyman Sachs, a sensitive and accomplished musician to whom the success of these gramophone records is no less due than to Rev. Backon.
