Last Thursday night's Symphony Concert in the City Hall was of particular interest in that the first half of the programme was taken charge of by Mr. Hermann Weigert, who conducted three items—the "Freischütz" and "Merry Wives" overtures and the prelude and finale from "Tristan."

All three items were conducted with great skill and artistry. The overtures were taken in the style of forty to fifty years ago, this, of course representing the composer's intention much more accurately. The result was a beautiful sweetness and fullness of tone.

The prelude and finale were no less admirably rendered, Herr Weigert's interpretation of Wagner being in perfect taste.

During the evening two operatic duets were sung by Mrs. Weigert and Miss Margot Corda. The first was "Schelm! halt fast," from the second act of "Der Freischütz," and the second was "Ah Guarda Sorelle" from Mozart's opera buffa, "Cosi fan Tutte." Both renderings were very pleasing and the two voices heard to excellent advantage.

After the interval Mr. Pickerill took his accustomed place to conduct the Schumann Symphony No. 4.

After the concert a large gathering of Mr. and Mrs. Weigert's friends assembled at their home in Oranienzicht to congratulate them on their splendid performance.
