

## German Post Office in Serious Position.

### RESULT OF DECLINE IN JEWISH ENTERPRISES.

Berlin.

Heavy losses by the German Post Office in the current year, amounting to over 600,000,000 marks as compared with last year, were disclosed by the Reich Minister of Posts, addressing German Press representatives in Berlin. He admitted that the losses were a direct result of the decline of Jewish enterprises, and that consequently the financial situation of the Post Office had become very serious and showed a deficit of 518,000,000 marks.

In spite of this, the Minister declared, the present policy of the Post Office in discriminating against Jewish firms would also be pursued in the future. No Jewish firm, he said, would get any contracts from Post Offices, and all orders from the Post Office Administration would be placed exclusively with Aryan firms.

## Jewish School System in Berlin.

### ENLARGED TO PROVIDE FOR 1,000 MORE CHILDREN.

Berlin.

The extension of the Jewish communal school system in Germany, in view of the present position, was announced at an official ceremony inaugurating new classes opened by the Jewish Community in Berlin.

Director Heinrich Stahl, the President of the Jewish Community of Berlin, said that the Jewish Community had in a very short space of time had to provide schools for over a thousand children, but a further extension of the communal school system would be necessary. The new schools were to give the children the training for a new practical life. The new educational activities of the community were only just beginning. It was to be hoped that, when permission of the Government had been obtained, it would be possible to open new communal schools in various parts of Berlin. He hoped that the teachers would meet the children with open hearts, and that the teaching of the children would be conducted not only in a Jewish religious but also in a German patriotic spirit. The children should be taught to consider themselves part of the Jewish community.

Efforts to extend the Jewish school system were also being made by the Jewish community in Munich.

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the organ of the Nationalist Socialist Party, expressed joy at the new order, and hopes that the day will come when the Jews will be compelled to bear special names by which they will be easily recognisable from non-Jews. "It should be possible," the paper states, "to distinguish all Jews by such specific Jewish names just as by the yellow badges which they were compelled to wear in the Middle Ages."

## Measures Against Jewish Students.

### NO JEW TO BE ENGAGED AS TUTOR.

Berlin.

The University of Berlin has issued an announcement that all Jewish students of German citizenship will have to apply to the Registrar of the University to have their students' cards stamped. Those students to whom the stamping of the card is refused will not be permitted in future to attend the University.

The new order means that all Jewish students at Berlin University will again come up for consideration, and since it is not stated on what grounds the Registrar may refuse to stamp the cards, his action will apparently be purely arbitrary, and the danger exists that the number of Jewish students may be considerably reduced.

At the same time the National Socialist Students Association has issued an order to all its members that they should forthwith break off all relations with any Jewish students whom they may have engaged to coach them in their examinations. In future, the order states, no Nazi student may employ a Jew as his coach.

The Government of the State of Lippe has ordered all schools throughout the State to introduce "raciology" as a compulsory subject in their curriculum. All pupils, the order states, will have to pass an examination on this subject before they can obtain their school certificate.

## Inculcating the Race Spirit.

### "EVEN THE TINIEST TODDLERS —."

Berlin.

The Federal Minister of the Interior, Dr. Frick, addressing a gathering of 15,000 teachers, declared that the most important task before them is to further the racial theory in education and in artistic life.

"The Nordic German race is the only race able to produce real art," said Dr. Frick. "For the last fourteen years it was dominated by non-German elements with the result that the old noble German traditions of art were destroyed, but now they will be restored in the real Nordic spirit."

The Bavarian Minister of Education, Dr. Schemm, spoke at a meeting of kindergarten teachers and youth leaders, and urged them to remember that race is the fundamental principle of the new Germany, and that all children, even the tiniest toddlers attending the kindergartens must be imbued with the race spirit.

Sylvia Sydney, the New York Jewish film star, is also having a tremendous success in Berlin now. No less than six films in which she stars are being shown in the principal Berlin cinemas, and are having an enthusiastic reception.

## President Masaryk and German Jewry.

### "ANXIOUS TO HELP."

Professor Masaryk, the President of Czecho-Slovakia, feels very keenly the tragedy of the German Jews and is anxious to help to find assistance for these 600,000 Hilsner Jews as he fought years ago to help the single Jew Leopold Hilsner, when he was on trial on the charge of ritual murder. This is what he told Mr. Nahum Sokolow, the President of the Zionist Organisation and the Jewish Agency, when he invited him recently to his summer residence at Topolcianky. Mr. Sokolow has stated in an interview with the Zionist organ "Die Stimme."

## Jewish Social Relief in Germany.

### GOVERNMENT WITHDRAWS SUBSIDIES.

Berlin.

The Prussian Government has issued an order withdrawing all the subsidies that were granted in the past to the Jewish Social Relief Association. With the help of these subsidies the Association was able to maintain many institutions, such as the Jewish Home for the Aged, the Jewish Home for the Blind, and a number of Jewish hospitals. All these institutions will now fall a burden on the Jewish Community.

## Entire Jewish Male Population Arrested.

### INCIDENT IN GERMAN TOWN.

The entire Jewish male population of Backingsfeld, in Westphalia, except two Jewish men who happened to be out of the town at the time, were suddenly arrested and taken into "protective custody."

No reason for the arrest was given.
