Isidor Epstein to Play.

On Thursday, the 19th inst, the first concert of the series of ten to be given by the Johannesburg Symphony Society during 1935/36 will take place at the Wanderers Hall.

A magnificent programme of orchestral masterpieces has been arranged for the opening concert of the Society's second season, the chief item of which will be Beethoven's seventh symphony: the apotheosis of the dance.

Mr. Isador Epstein, who has not been heard with an orchestra for some considerable time, will be the soloist in Schubert's famous "Wanderer Phantasie," the brilliant orchestral accompaniment of which is by Fr. Liszt. The Johannesburg Symphony Orchestra of 48 players, led by Mr. Weinbrenn, will be under the baton of Mr. Joseph Traunek.
