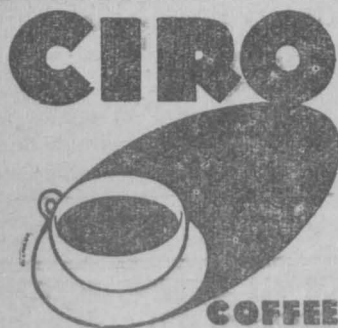

**WHERE WILL YOU VOTE?
A REMINDER**

ONLY two weeks are left before the Parliamentary elections take place. All those who can vote should exercise their privilege on May 18. It is their duty as South Africans to do so.

Voters who have moved from their old addresses, or are, for other reasons, doubtful of the constituency in which they are entitled to vote, should ascertain in which constituency they may vote and make the necessary arrangements to cast their votes, either in person or by post.

The required information may be obtained from the central offices of the various parties or from the committee rooms of the candidates.

Second Recital by Szigeti

Szigeti's first recital in Johannesburg has left music-lovers impatiently eager for his next. His incomparable gifts as a great artist, and the flawless beauty of the tone he extracts from his violin have astonished and entranced all who heard him. His second recital here, therefore, which will take place at the Standard Theatre on Friday night, should be another great event in the musical life of the city.

On this occasion his programme will include Handel's Sonata in D Major, Bach's Chaconne (for violin alone) and Mendelssohn's Concerto for Violin, Op. 64, while among the smaller numbers are Caprice in E (Paganini), Study in Thirds (Scriabin-Szigeti), and Aubade (Lala-Szigeti).

Szigeti's accompanist for his South African tour is Endre Petri, whose reputation as a polished pianist and understanding accompanist stands high to-day. As a soloist, he has delicacy of touch, sensitiveness and lucidity.

**AN OLD PIONEER PASSES
The Late Wulf Cohen**

One of the most picturesque personalities in the Jewish life of Johannesburg passed away at his home on Sunday morning, at the age of 80. The late Mr. Wulf Cohen came to Johannesburg from Russia in the 'nineties, and established a business in the manufacture of matzos. He was active throughout his life and during the recent Passover he took an interest in his matzoh.

It may be recollected by the older residents of this city that when British troops were marching on the Orange Free State during the Anglo-Boer War, Mr. Cohen granted a special permit to him to travel to Bloemfontein to obtain a supply of kosher flour. The flour was being ground in a mill in the British Army's possession, and the British Army was looting the city, and the sound of the battle could be heard in the distance.

The deceased is survived by three sons (in Johannesburg), a daughter (in the United States), and 15 grandchildren.

The funeral, which took place on Monday, was largely attended.

"Chosen People" Debate Postponed

THE Natal Dutch Reformed Church Synod sitting in Durban postponed consideration of whether the Jews are regarded as the "chosen people" because any decision made would be used for political ends. The mission has been appointed to prepare a report on the subject for the next synod. Its decision and postponement of discussion was approved by a two-thirds majority.
