MR. PHILIP WARTSKI

Eighty-six Years Old on Monday

On Monday next, Mr. Philip Wartski, the well-known communal worker of Durban, will celebrate his eighty-sixth birthday.

MR. WARTSKI landed in Durban on April 7th, 1882, and has always been keenly interested in the community, of which he is an honoured member. Together with a handful of pioneers, he assisted in the establishment of the first Hebrew Congregation in Durban, which came into being in 1883. It was in 1903 that Mr. Wartski, as President of the Congregation, laid the foundation stone of the present Synagogue in St. Andrews Street.

Although owing to his advanced age Mr. Wartski is unable to participate actively to-day in the life of the Durban Jewish community, he is keenly interested in every aspect of its progress.

He will undoubtedly be the recipient on Monday next of many congratulatory messages from a large number of relatives and friends in this country and overseas.
