A PESACH FUNCTION Transvaal Zionist Youth

The annual Pesach function organised by the Transvaal Zionist Youth Executive took place in a happy atmosphere at the Coronation Hall on Wednesday, the 8th April. There was a large crowd present and particularly noticeable was the fact that the majority (as different from previous years) were of a much younger age than usual.

The four "Kashes" (Questions) were asked by Chaver Sandler—a member of Habonim—and were ably answered by Chaverim E. Shmuelson (Chairman of the meeting), L. Krokin (Segan Ba-Koach of Johannesburg Habonim), M. Udwin (an ex-member of the Eastern Cape Zionist Youth Executive) and D. Dunsky, a prominent member of the Youth Council. The speeches dwelt in particular on the idea of Freedom for the Jewish people as symbolised by Pesach. After the tea interval, the arrangements for which were made by Chavera S.
