## Mr. J. Herbstein.

### APPOINTED K.C.

Congratulations are extended to Adv. Joseph Herbstein on his appointment as K.C.

Mr. Herbstein was born in 1897 and received his early education at Graaff-Reinet.

He studied at Rhodes University College, Grahamstown and at the University of Cape Town. He taught at Grey's Institute, Port Elizabeth and was admitted to the Cape Bar in 1922 where he has been in practice since. He has had a very successful career at the Bar.

Mr. Herbstein is one of the best-known communal and Zionist workers in the Jewish community of this country. He occupied the position of Chairman of the D.Z.A. for several years and was Chairman of the Keren Hayesod during the last Campaign. He was also for many years a member of the Editorial Board of the S.A. Jewish Chronicle, a position which he resigned recently owing to pressure of work.

### BEQUESTS TO JEWISH CHARITIES.

The Will of the late Mr. Moritz Barash, who died recently at Sea Point, contains a number of bequests to charitable institutions. The Cape Jewish Board of Guardians will receive £1,000; the Groote Schuur Hospital, £100; Cape Town Hebrew Congregation, £200; United Hebrew Schools, £100; Cape Jewish Aged Home, £100; Cape Jewish Orphanage, £100; Jewish Sick Relief Society, £100.

Besides other legacies to relatives the residue of the estate is left to his wife.

## Protest Meeting in Kimberley.

A strong protest against the policy of the British Government, as enunciated in the White Paper on Palestine, was made at a representative gathering of Kimberley Jewry on Sunday night.

An emphatic resolution describing the White Paper as an unjustifiable scrapping of solemn promises made by Great Britain in the Balfour Declaration, was unanimously passed.

The meeting rejected the plan formulated in the White Paper, expressing determination to support fully all measures to nullify its effect, and passed a resolution similar to that passed at the meeting in Johannesburg.
