failed hopelessly, but unfortunately succeeded in contaminating and poisoning a handful of individuals in South Africa most of them "innocents" who were suddenly converted by the preachings of the "New Testament" of the "new" Zionists. They have succeeded in catching a few "chair" seekers who were offered titles such as Life Presidents, Presidents and Chairmen.

Then there is "illegal immigration" for which they claim so much credit. Yet it can be proved that of the large number of illegal immigrants who entered Palestine since the outbreak of war, only about 16 per cent. were brought in by the official Revisionist body.

Again a cry arose from "Nazo" quarters that the world Zionist organisation made an agreement with the Roumanian government; this is also absolutely baseless and untrue as proved by the London Jewish Chronicle, which is quite impartial.

Now last week a new story has been manufactured: A split is alleged to have taken place in the ranks of the Zionist movement in America, and Dr. Weizmann to have left American shores hurriedly after friction had arisen between the Lipsky group and a number of leaders who are not named at all. This is also cheap propaganda of the Goebbels type.

The Fascist tendency of Revisionism is forcing battles upon us which we do not relish. We shall, however, be compelled to continue our fight not only in the interests of the Jewish masses, but for the sake of Zionism and all Jewry.

It is for this reason that I feel that the articles published in your esteemed paper of late have proved that the Revisionists are a group who deal in slogans, make capital out of our misfortunes, and fish in troubled water. South African Zionism must, once and for all, show the real character of the so-called "purified" Jewish Nationalists.—I am, etc.,

Inspiring Sound Films of Eretz Israel.

TWO NEW RELEASES TO BE SCREENED.

Considerable interest attaches to the announcement made elsewhere in this issue that two new films depicting the great task of national reconstruction in Eretz Israel are to be released in Cape Town next week.

The first is a full-length film produced by the J.N.F. entitled "A Homeland in the Making." It presents a vivid picture of the latest achievements in land acquisition and general progress in Palestine, and was very well received when exhibited recently in Johannesburg and on the Reef. The film is exceptionally well produced and the English commentary is given by a B.B.C. announcer.

The second film is an even more recent production and is called "There is Hope for Thy Children." It deals graphically with the work of the Youth Aliyah in its rehabilitation of young Jewish lives and the transplanting of young Jewish children from countries of persecution to a land of new opportunities and freedom. It is a sound film similar to the former.

Both these outstanding pictures, which are accompanied by a full supporting programme, will be shown at the Zionist Hall, Hope Street, Cape Town, on the evenings of Thursday, April 11th, and Saturday, April 13th, commencing at 8.15 p.m. Admission prices are 2s. and 1s. 3d. including tax, and tickets are obtainable and seats may be reserved at Messrs. Polliacks Ltd., Adderley Street. A special children's matinee will take place on Monday, April 15th, commencing at 3.15 p.m. Admission will be 6d. including tax.
