

Mr. Henry Katzen Appointed Choirmaster of Vredehoek Synagogue.

Mr. Henry Katzen has been appointed Choirmaster of the Vredehoek Synagogue.

Mr. Katzen, who was born in Russia, came to South Africa in 1921, and began to study the violin under Mr. Alfred Gibbs, the present leader of the Cape Town Orchestra. He then entered the South African College of Music where he spent seven years studying harmony, counterpoint and composition with Professor Bell and the violin under Mr. George Tobias and Mr. Ellie Marx.

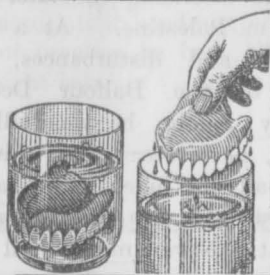
He joined the Cape Town Municipal Orchestra as a student violinist in 1931 and had the distinction of playing under Sir Henry Wood, Sir Granville Bantock and other eminent guest conductors. Mr. Katzen spent a considerable amount of time studying choral music, and is well acquainted with the works of Jewish choral composers such as Lewandowsky, Sulzer, Mombach, Birenbaum and Elman. He was Choirmaster of the Germiston Synagogue in 1933 and Muizenberg Synagogue in 1935. Mr. Katzen, in collaboration with Cantor Inspektor, will direct the choir in the Vredehoek Synagogue during the forthcoming High Festivals.

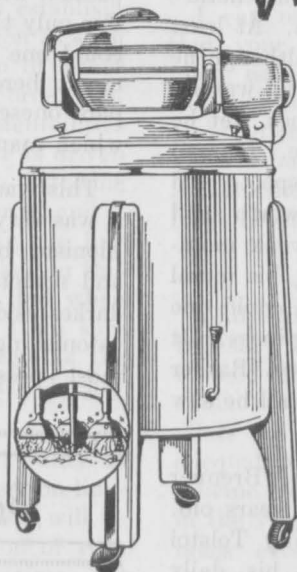
